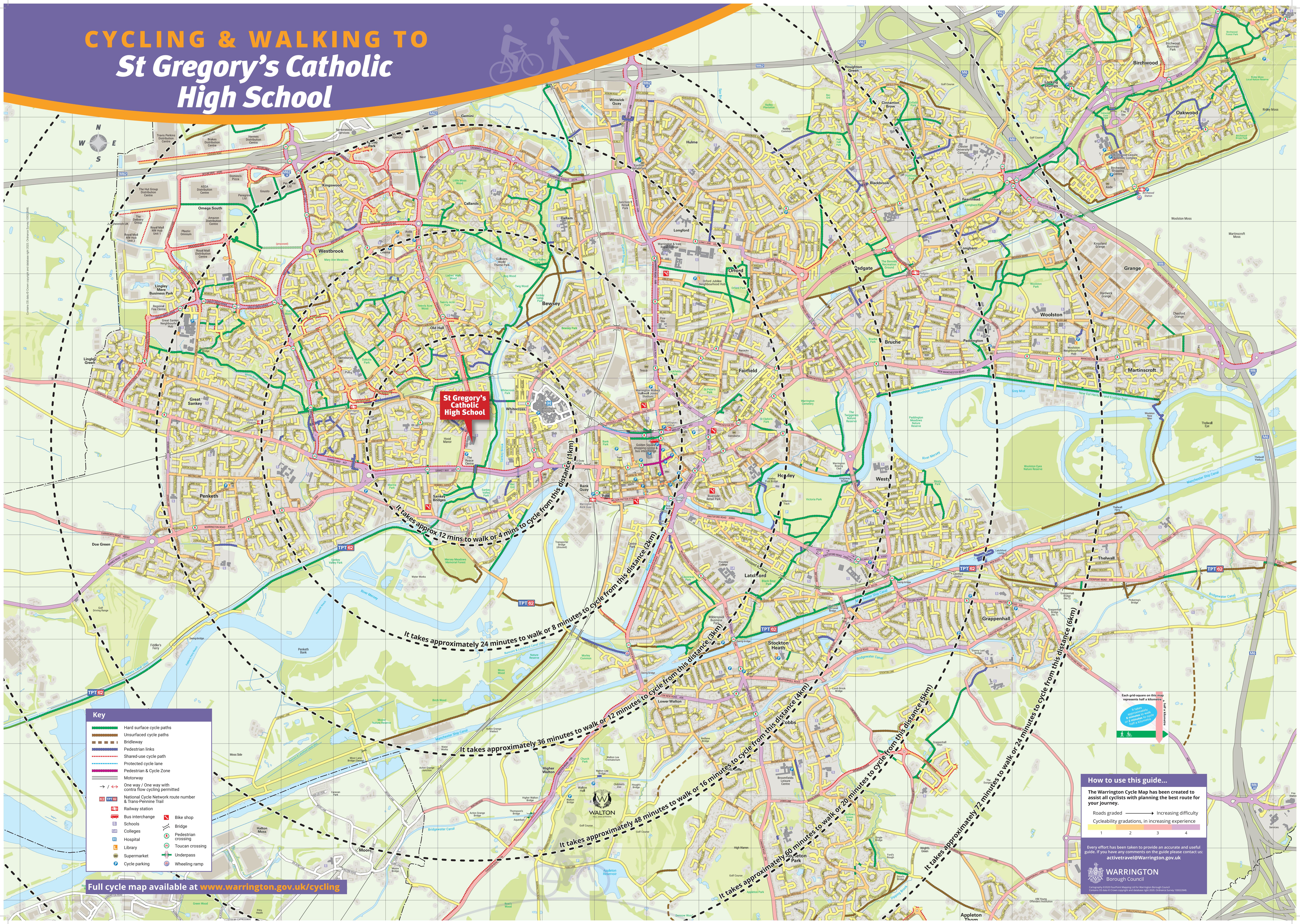


CYCLING & WALKING TO St Gregory's Catholic High School
