We've become accustomed to the foodbanks in the doorways of our supermarkets. We've become accustomed to foodbank volunteers handing out leaflets at the bottom of the supermarket escalators. But what we must try to remember is that in 2020/21 approximately 2.5 million people used a food bank in the United Kingdom, over 600 thousand more than the previous year. Throughout the provided time the number of food bank users has increased in every year, from just under 26 thousand in 2008/09.
