Dear Parents and Carers

Please find the arrangements for your child to access their learning whilst working from home on Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> April and Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> May 2023.

Below are the details on how to access the planned lessons and resources via the Class Charts Announcements app. Where a lesson is using Seneca as part of the resource, information is provided to support pupils in accessing Seneca.

All the lessons are to **Class Charts Announcements** where the lesson is clearly marked for that particular period of the day.

Pupils have been using Class Charts since September, but if for any reason they have forgotten their Class Charts code, their Pastoral Support Manager and Pupil Progress Manager have been checking with each form that all pupils have their codes. All pupils have also revisited using these software packages in their computing lessons. In the event that your child forgets their code, please contact your child's pastoral support manager who will be able to help your son / daughter access Class Charts and their learning.

Pupils can access Class Charts and Seneca from the RM Unify portal. www.rmunify.com

<u>Seneca</u>: Pupils access the Seneca tile via the RM Unify platform that they are very familiar with. They just need to logon to <u>rmunify.com</u> and type in their school email address and password. To access Seneca they just need to click on the Seneca tile on RM Unify and type in their school email address and the password <u>seneca2020</u>. If they have changed their password and have forgotten it, they can click on "forgotten password" and follow the link sent to their school email address.

Pupils will complete four lessons of an hour and 15 minutes. Extra time has been allocated to support them with their independent learning, and also allow for rest breaks from screen time. Pupils should not spend longer than one hour and fifteen minutes on each activity.
