Year 9 Bespoke Curriculum Choices 2023 – 2025

Dear Parent / Carer,

The Year 9 Engage Evening will be taking place on **Thursday 16th February 2023** from **3.45 p.m. to 7.00 p.m.** The Engage Evening will also incorporate an important Year 9 Curriculum Talk, and a Pupil Led Marketplace meaning the night will have great significance for you and your child.

During the evening, there will be an opportunity to:

- Discuss your child's current performance in each of their subjects, with particular focus on the subjects they are considering choosing. This is also an opportunity to ask questions about KS4 study and preparation.
- Attend a Senior Leadership talk to explain pupil choices and KS4 curriculum.
- Visit the Pupil Led marketplace for all KS4 subjects where students can ask questions and gain more of an insight into potential subjects they may wish to choose.
