Dear Parents and Carers,

Intervention sessions for Year 11

It is a pleasure to write to you regarding the excellent progress that Year 11 students are making upon returning to St Gregory's, which has been paired with an excellent attitude to learning displayed by the year group. It is clear to see they are striving to reach their potential in their final year at St Gregory's Catholic High School.

Each year, subject teachers often provide intervention sessions for Year 11 students. This comes in the form of after-school sessions, each evening, usually, from 3pm-4pm as well as some pre-school sessions. These sessions focus on providing support through: targeted group sessions, extra lessons on specific subject content, sessions on examination skills and technique, as well as offering opportunities to work on past paper questions with teacher support.

It should be noted that not all students will be required to attend all intervention sessions, and subjects arrange them at their discretion at varying points of the year to support their curriculum best. We believe in offering, where possible, bespoke and targeted intervention to small groups. Subject teachers will invite pupils as they are best placed to make decisions on the support needed for their students individually. If you have any concerns about your child's progress for Individual subjects, and the intervention available, the best process is for the pupil to speak to their teacher, or their Pupil Progress Manager.

Below, you will see a table identifying subjects and their support evening(s). Some subjects may offer additional support for your child on other days, but they should place preference on the subject allocated to that day if they are invited to multiple sessions. The option code 'A/B/C' refers to the letter on the pupil's timetable (ClassCharts) for that subject.
